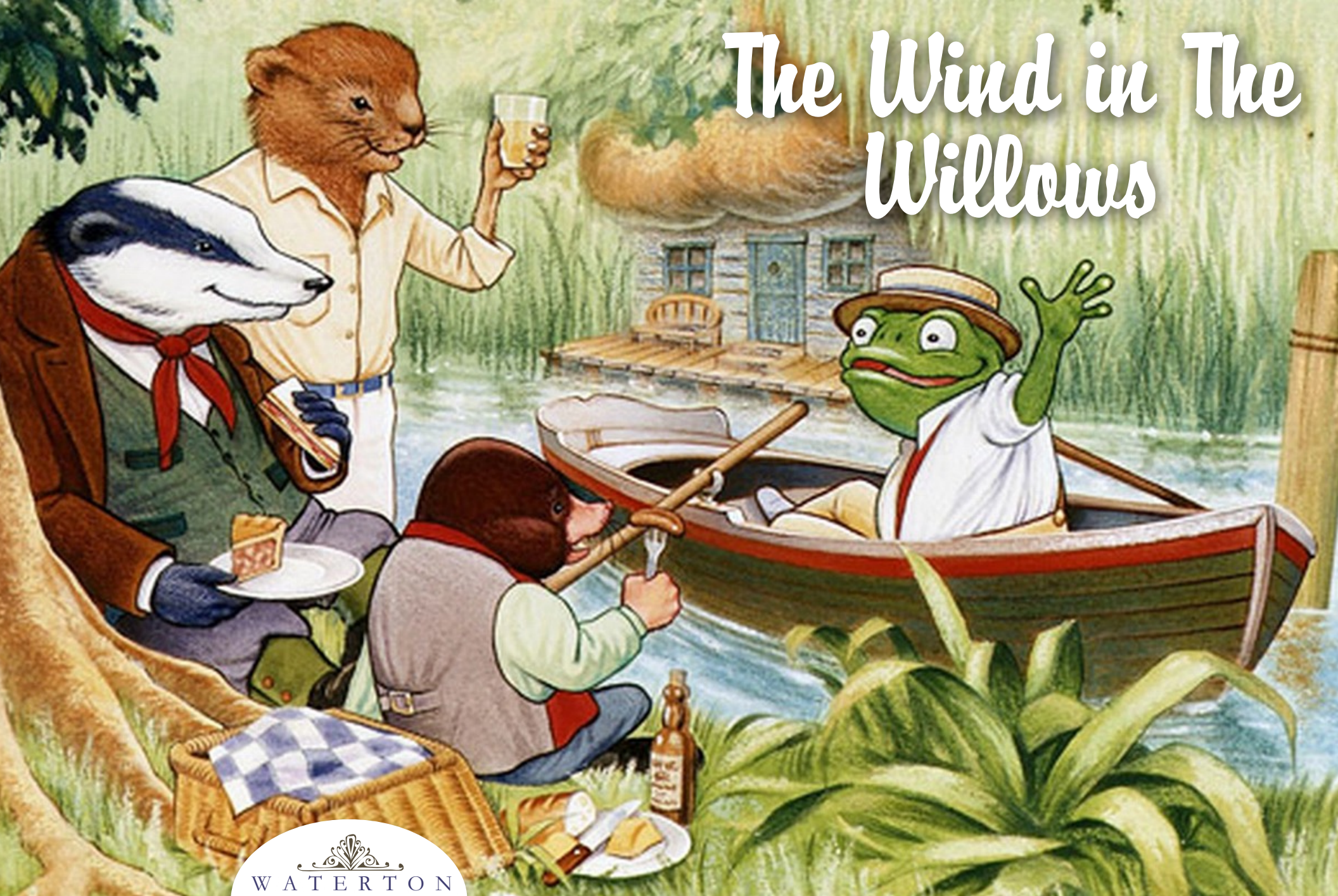


The Wind in The Willows
